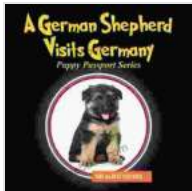


A German Shepherd's Journey to Germany: Exploring the Country with a Puppy Passport

Day 2: Exploring Neuschwanstein Castle, a Fairy Tale Come True

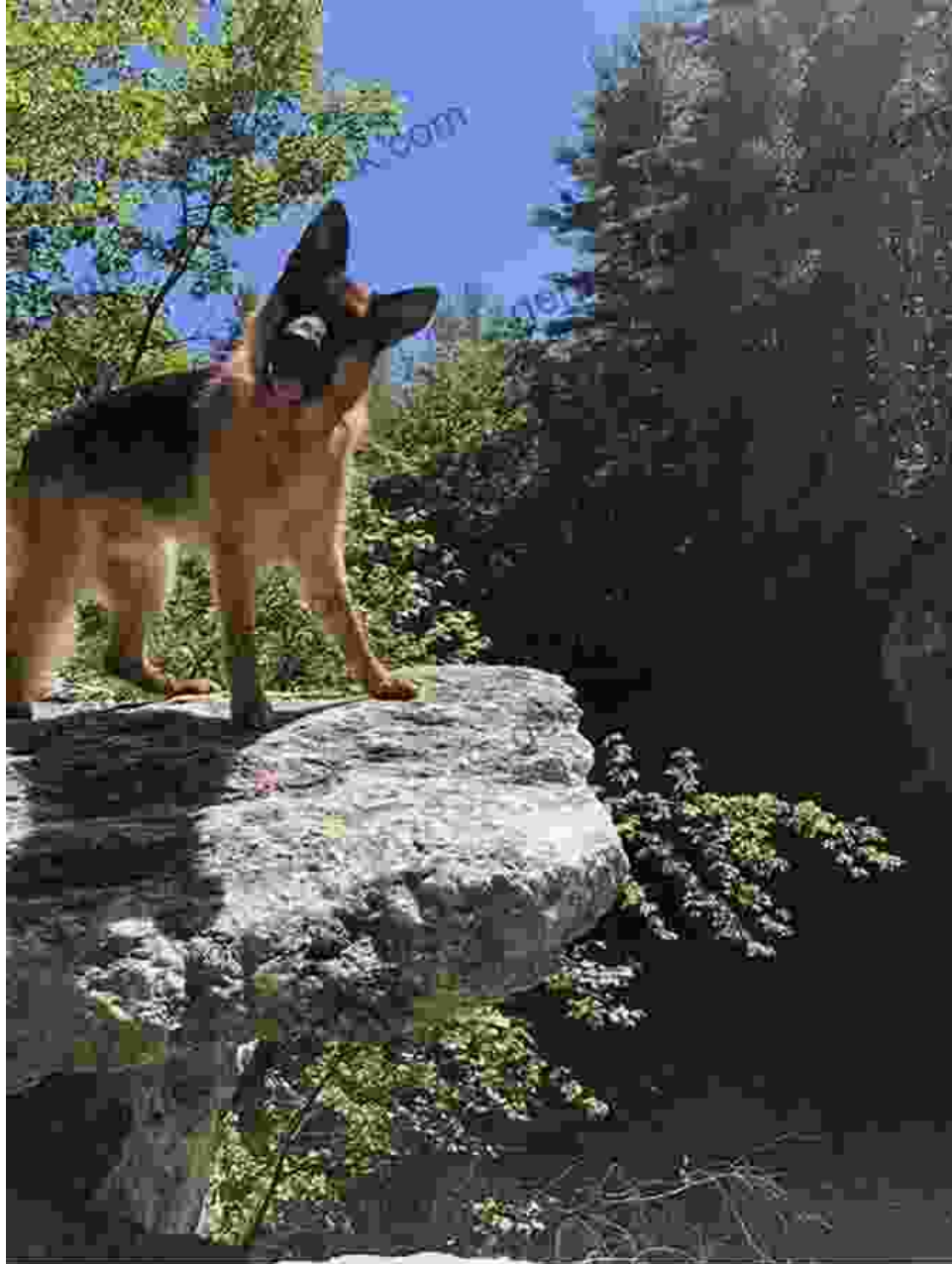


Buddy, the German Shepherd puppy, gazed up at Neuschwanstein Castle, a majestic sight that seemed straight out of a fairy tale.

From Munich, they boarded a river cruise that would take them along the picturesque Rhine River. Buddy watched in amazement as castles and vineyards lined the banks.

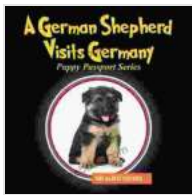
