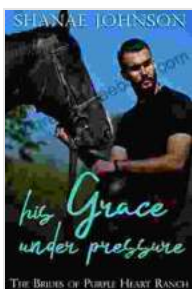

"I wouldn't miss it for the world," Jake said.

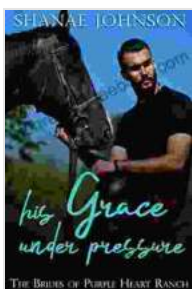
Sarah and Jake sat down on the couch next to each other. They talked for a while, and then they both got up to go get some food.
